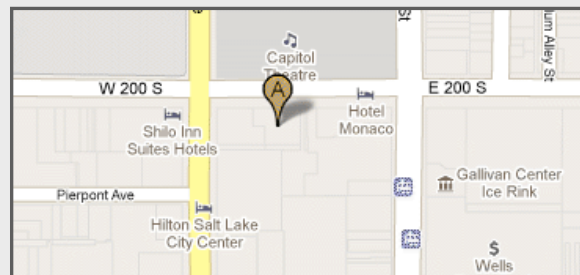

Join the Health Justice Vending Partner Program

What is the Health Justice Vending Partner program?



We partner with you and with the owner of your vending machine and distribute a portion of the vending company sales to causes and people who bring affordable health care closer to reality: Community clinics, medical outreach programs and educational programs are a few examples of ways you contribute to bring about a healthier, stronger America.

What do I have to do?

You only need to provide a small space in your business location to host a machine. Your vending machine owner will service

the machine on a regular basis and will provide you with the label identifying the machine with our charitable mission.

Your Vending Machine Owner can also provide you with a letter or appreciation, suitable for framing, to display in your business.

What's in it for my business?

Because you are giving space to a charitable organization, you may be able to deduct the rental value of that space from your taxes.

Some location owners deduct as much as \$600 per year for this charitable contribution-in-kind. Consult your accountant to see if you qualify.
